
RECRUITMENT

Students to be recruited to a PhD studies in Mechanics at Lublin University of Technology are required to have successfully completed a graduate degree from a recognised university enabling access to doctoral programmes in their home country. Furthermore, the applicant must fulfil the following entry requirements:

- hold a university degree with a focus in mechanics or in the subject relevant to mechanics The final score at least 'good' or an equivalent one is mandatory,
- receive the prior written consent of the academic enrolled at Lublin University of Technology and entitled to be a PhD supervisor,
- receive the prior written consent of the head of the department at Lublin University of Technology where the PhD programme will be run,
- shall demonstrate proficiency to speak and understand English to the extent he/she is able to communicate effectively,
- have successfully pass the recruitment procedure

Candidates applying for the International PhD studies in Mechanics shell submit the following documents (copies in Polish language or certified true copies in English):

- 1) application standard form as set out under the regulations of the Rector of Lublin University of Technology; a written consent/letter of recommendation of the academic enrolled at Lublin University of Technology and entitled to be a PhD supervisor,
- 2) diploma of completion of higher education studies (master degree) enabling access to doctoral programmes,
- 3) official academic transcripts from the school of graduation that will include all courses you attended and details of degree examinations,
- 4) personal questionnaire consistent with the template set out by the Rector of Lublin University of Technology regulations
- 5) CV containing the following information:
 - a. graduated studies, topic of the diploma thesis and other possible reports certifying the university graduate,
 - b. description of scientific interests in the field of mechanics, possible research proposal,
 - c. professional experience,

- d. scientific activities (published papers, participation in scientific research projects, activities at the students research centres, participation in scientific conferences etc.),
 - e. other activities (postgraduate studies, specialist courses, skills development workshops, industry internships, foreign internships, prizes and honours received, scholarships, any other extracurricular activities);
- 6) documents, diplomas, certificates and other evidence of formal qualifications and activities referenced in points 5d and 5e,
 - 7) a medical certificate attesting to the candidate capacity to carry out the studies on regular basis and proving there are no doctor's contraindications,
 - 8) average grade from master degree studies certified by university authorities,
 - 9) certificate of proficiency in English confirming successful completion of one of the approved English language tests: IELTS, TOEFL or PTE ,
 - 10) two printed photos (4,5 x 6,5 cm size) accompanied by an electronic copy on CD/DVD,
 - 11) a copy of a valid national passport (page with photo) or any other personal document confirming the identity of the applicant. The provided copy have to be certified by the local university authorities.
